

Bible Study Topic:

Promises for Broken Relationships

- Psalms 147:3** God recognizes your broken heart and promises to heal it.
- Isaiah 49:15-16** The person who is dearest to you may dump you, but the Lord never will. Those nail scars in His hands are your initials carved forever in the palms of His hands. He's paid too dearly for you to ever desert you.
- Deut. 31:6** Imagine God walking beside you, being your companion and your strength.
- Psalms 43:5** The pain WILL diminish – you will be happy again!
- Jeremiah 33:3** God has a future planned for you that will exceed your best and favorite plans for yourself.
- Matt. 25:33-40** Don't wallow in self-pity. There are many people out there who need your help. Your own pain will ease when you comfort someone else.
- Jeremiah 49:11** God promises to provide you the emotional (and financial: Deut. 10:18) support that you obtained previously from a human companion or family member.
- Ephesians 4:31-32** Forgive the person who hurt you.
- Matt. 5:4** Blessed means "happy." Think about it.
- Proverbs 18:24** Get out there and make some new FRIENDS! (Emphasis on "friends." Don't jump too quickly into an intense relationship. Hold on to your hats, gang, and tune in if you just "broke up." You wouldn't be hurting right now if you'd been into group dating or friendship dating instead of that exclusive stuff.)
