

Bible Study Topic:

Justification by Faith

- I John 5: 10-13** If we have accepted Jesus as our Substitute and Savior, we can KNOW we are saved. Trust Him!
- Romans 3:23** Every one of us has sinned.
- Romans 6:23** The wages of sin is death, but Jesus took that punishment in our place.
- John 3:16** If you accept Jesus as your Messiah and King, you have eternal life.
- Ephesians 2:8, 9** Our salvation is a gift from God. We can never, never earn it.
- Romans 5:1** Justified means “made right”. Jesus makes us right, or righteous. By faith in Him, His goodness becomes our goodness. He changes our hearts as we meditate about Him.
- John 1:12** When we pray “Lord Jesus, save me! I accept you and believe you died for ME” then God accepts us into His family. We are His – forever.
- Isaiah 1:18** With His blood, Jesus washes away our sins and we stand before God wonderfully clean! Believe Him.
- I Cor. 6:9-11** God’s Spirit leads us to repentance (feeling sorry for our sins and turning away from it) and justification (our title to heaven). That same Spirit teaches us how to live after we’ve been justified. (That process is called “sanctification”).
- John 14:15** Are you thankful for salvation? Show Jesus your thanks!
