

Bible Study Topic:

Satan

- Ezekiel 28:12-15** God created Lucifer a perfect sinless being, capable of choice.
- Isaiah 14:12-14** Lucifer indulged his pride and coveted God's position and power (Note: In verse 12, many translations call Lucifer "star of the morning." The King James version uses the term "Lucifer").
- Revelation 12:7-9** There was war in heaven and Lucifer (now Satan), was thrown out with his angels (Luke 10:18)
- Genesis 3:1-7** Satan tempted our first parents in the Garden of Eden. Satan's Big Line is: Don't trust God with your happiness.
- John 14:30** Satan now claims to be prince of this world. Therefore, the tragedy that stalks Planet Earth in the form of disease, disaster, and violence is attributable to Satan's government, not God's.
- John 12:31-33** Christ's death insured that Jesus will eventually be the Prince of this earth, not Satan.
- Revelation 21:3-4** Soon God will take His kingdom back from Satan's dominion, and there will be no more sad things.
- Ezekiel 28:16-18** Using the imagery of "King of Tyre" the Lord traces the history and future of Satan from a perfect being created by God, to the Garden of Eden, and on to his ultimate destruction.
- Malachi 4:1, 3** Satan, the root, with his followers, the branch, will be fully destroyed—consumed by the fires of the final destruction of the wicked.
- Nahum 1:9** Satan's awful experiment will soon be over and sin will never occur.
