

## Bible Study Topic:

### Once Saved, Always Saved???

- Ezekiel 33:13** Your past acceptance of Jesus will not automatically insure your future salvation if you subsequently turn your back on Him.
- Romans 11:22** After you have been grafted into the Vine (Jesus), you can be broken off for unbelief.
- I Corinthians 9:2** Paul had been converted on the road to Damascus, but he cautions himself not to release his hold on Jesus lest he disqualify himself from salvation.
- Hebrews 10:26-27** A caution to maintain our hold on Jesus, our example and substitute, lest we LOSE our salvation.
- Ezekiel 18:24** Our good deeds will never save us. It is only as we retain Jesus as our Savior that we can stand before God without sin.
- Colossians 1:22-2** Paul emphasizes the importance of CONTINUING to live out the gospel.
- II Peter 2:18-21** Hold fast- endure- keep the faith- don't give in to sensual desire, or you will be worse off than you were before you accepted Jesus.
- Revelation 3:5** Your name can be erased from the book of life.
