

Bible Study Topic:

The Unpardonable Sin

- Matt. 12:31, 32** If we grieve the Holy Spirit away, God has no way of speaking to keep our hearts and drawing us to Him. Jesus is the one who pardons or forgives our sins, and if we don't come to Him, our sin remains unpardoned.
- John 16:8** The Holy Spirit is the agency that convicts us of sin. That Spirit also points to the solution to our sinful condition: Jesus Christ. To reject the Spirit means to reject Jesus, who is our only hope of salvation.
- Genesis 6:3** Every time we reject the Spirit's call, we build up a layer of resistance that makes hearing Him increasingly difficult. If we persist in tuning Him out, eventually we don't hear Him at all. In that sense it can be said "The Spirit no longer strives with us."
- Ephesians 4:30** The Holy Spirit is a real Personage, capable of being hurt by our indifference.
- I Thess. 5:19** Don't turn off the voice of the Spirit!
- Hebrews 10:26, 27** Persisting willfully to practice what we know to be sin is **dangerous!**
- Ephesians 4:19** If we continue to reject the Spirit's call to purity of heart and life, pretty soon we see nothing wrong with stuff that breaks God's heart.
- John 6:37** If you have a longing just now to cleanse you, you have not committed the unpardonable sin. If you come to Him, He will not cast you away.
- Hebrews 3:7-8** Don't postpone your decision for Christ!
- Revelation 22:17** If you hear that sweet Spirit of God knocking at your hearts door, let Him enter today!
